WET BURLAP BAGS. CAMPS WILL BE CHECKED THROUGHTOUT THE
WEEKEND FOR THESE ITEMS.

FIRE WATCH FOR ALL BATTALIONS AND MODERN CAMPS. UNION
INFNATRY, UNION CAVALRY, CONFEDERATE INFANTRY, CONFEDERATE
CAVALRY, UNION ARTILLERY, CONFEDERATE ARTILLERY AND
CIVILIANS WILL ALL HAVE FIRE WATCH DUTIES.

ALL FIRES, CANDLES AND LANTERNS WILL BE COMPLETELY PUT OUT
BEFORE LEAVING OR GOING TO SLEEP. ABSOLUTELY NO FIRES,
CANDLES OR LANTERNS WILL BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.
BATTLEFIELD: ALL ATRILLERY: TAKE EXTRA BUCKETS OF WATER, THE
WET BURLAP BAGS AND SHOVELS EVEN FIRE EXTINGUISHER IF YOU
HAVE IT. INFANTRY AND CAVALRY: MAKE SURE CANTEENS ARE FULL,
TAKE EXTRA CANTEENS IF YOU HAVE IT.
DO NOT THROW CIGARETTE BUTTS ON THE GROUND.
